Badge of rank 1st DAN :

After 1kyu. Qualificational period: Minimum of 100 hours during one consecutive year of continuous discipline. + Participating in at least two camps. Absence and periods of leave will lead to immediate disqualification !

- 1. Kihon renzokuwaza (Shomen-uchi or yokomen-uchi)*
- 2. Kokyunage renzokuwaza (Katate-dori, Ryote-dori, Morote-dori, Ryokata-dori e.t.c.)*
- 3. Tanto-dori 3techniques.*
- 4. 31 Jo-kata, 13 Jo-kata.*
- 5. Bokuto-suburi 1-7.*

Points of importance:

- 1. Distance, timing, tempo & zanshin. Body attitude, mental attitude,*
- 2. EXTRA steps and passes not excepted.*

Badge of rank 2nd DAN :

After 1st Dan Qualificational period: Minimum of 200 hours during two consecutive years of continuous discipline. + Participating in at least four camps. Absence and periods of leave will lead to immediate disqualification !

- 1. Same as for 1st dan.**
- 2. Tanto-dori 5 techniques**
- 3. 31 Jo-kumijo awase.**
- 4. Kumi-tachi 1-5.**
- 5. Jo-dori 5 techniques**
- 6. Tachi-dori 5 techniques**

Points of importance ; as above +

- 1. All techniques should be shown in a powerful flow of expression and in strict mental concentration .**
- 2. Awareness of the opponent's energy.**

Badge of rank 3rd DAN :

After 2nd dan Qualificational period: Minimum of 300 hours during three consecutive years of continuous discipline. + Participating in at least four camps. Absence and periods of leave will lead to immediate disqualification !

Plan and perform ca. 20 minute demonstration of Taijutsu, Aiki-ken & jo, Tanto dori, Jo dori & tachi dori .

Key notes; as above +

- 1. Being aware of movements that is occurring away from your immediate focus, what happens beside you and behind you.*
- 2. The opponent appears - steps in to your field-range of energy.*
- 3. The choice of an appropriate Uke reflects the level of understanding and maturity of the candidate.*
